Your camera-ready copy will be printed exactly as it has been submitted, so please make sure your text has been proofread with care. Table 1 summarises the most important settings. Please use the suggested table and figure layouts to ensure a high degree of consistency in printing the proceedings.

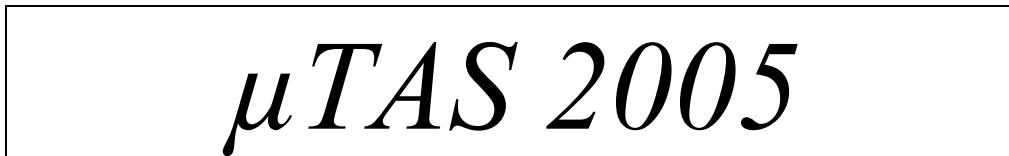


Figure 1. Example figure
